Ms. Levitt is the co-author of *The Lawyer's Guide to Fact Finding on the Internet* (2nd Ed.), published by the American Bar Association. In addition, she is the co-author of *How to Use the Internet for Legal and Investigative Research and Discover the Internet*. Ms. Levitt is the regular contributor to the Los Angeles Lawyer magazine's "Computer Counselor" column (whose column reaches 25,000 attorneys). She is also a contributor to *The Internet Lawyer* and *Research Advisor* newsletters and to the websites FindLaw.com and LLRX.com.

Ms. Levitt serves as the Chair of the California Bar's Law Practice Management & Technology Section and is an Executive Board Member of LACBA's Law Practice Management Section. She is also the former Vice-President of the 400-member Southern California Association of Law Libraries. She belongs to the Illinois and California State Bar Associations and to the Los Angeles County Bar Association (LACBA). Additionally, Levitt is a member of the Association of Continuing Legal Education (ACLEA).
